Dear Lord,

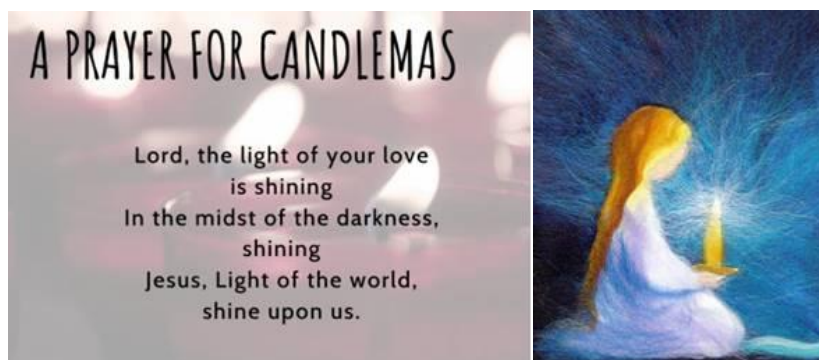
When we go astray, Jesus, our Good Shepherd, always welcomes us back with joy and makes us new again.
