

#### Summer Term Reminders

As the weather becomes warmer, please take note of the following reminders to help keep children comfortable and safe during the school day:

- Water Bottles: Children should bring a labelled water bottle to school each day to stay hydrated.
- Sun Cream: Please apply sun cream to your child before school. If you would like them to reapply it during the day, kindly send in a *named* bottle and inform the class teacher.
- Sun Hats: We recommend that children bring a *labelled* sun hat to wear during outdoor activities to protect them from the sun.
- Named Clothing: Jumpers and cardigans are often removed during warm weather. Please ensure that all clothing is clearly labelled to help prevent items from being lost.

### PUPIL PREMIUM

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Have Your Circumstances Changed?

All pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are offered a free and healthy school lunch, known as Universal Free School Meals (UFSM) whether they are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM) or not. Even if your child receives UFSM, it is still important for the school to know whether eligibility exists for FSM as this may lead to additional school funding. Children in school years 3 to 6 will be offered a free lunch if they meet certain criteria for FSM as laid down by the government.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals; your child is eligible for free school meals if you are in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- The guaranteed part of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as your annual gross income is £16,190 or less and you don't get Working Tax Credit)
- Working Tax Credit run-off after you come off Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit that you applied for on, or after, 1 April 2018 (as long as your household income is less than £7,400 a year after tax, not including any benefits)

Children with parents who are serving/have served in the regular armed forces may also be eligible for funding as are children previously looked after by a local authority or other state care, including children adopted from state care or equivalent from outside England and Wales.

Registering for Free School Meals could raise up to an extra £1,515 in Pupil Premium for the school to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or after school activities.
